Trust me, even individually, these messages have an impact. You will receive direct responses from many of your messages; they are definitely read. Every single SAFE OSIDE member should complete this sheet without exception. We are ACTIVEists!!!

☐ (STEP 1) - TELL AT LEAST 5 NEIGHBORS OR FRIENDS TO JOIN

The first and most important step is that we grow in numbers. All of our initiatives will be magnitudes more effective with larger numbers. Face-to-face conversations with real people are the most effective, but also share on Nextdoor and social media. Tell people why you joined, and send them to <http://www.safeoside.org> to sign up. 99% of people I talked to are very grateful we are doing something, so this is a rewarding exercise.

☐ (STEP 7) : PREPARE TO REPORT INCIDENTS TO POLICE

Our police department can't address anything they don't see and we don't report. Many incidents are going unreported. Prepare to REPORT EVERYTHING – put this number in your phone so you can find it when you need it: (OPD Non-Emergency 760-435-4900)
